Setup

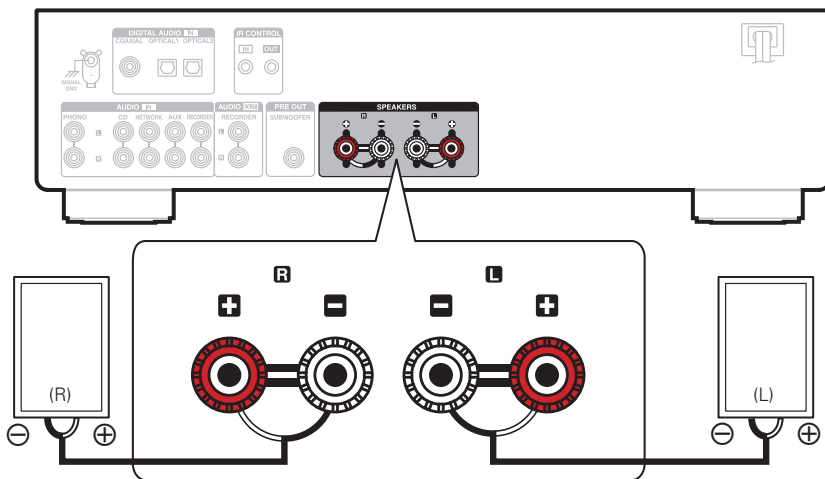
There are five steps to the setup process.

- 1** Install batteries in the remote control unit
- 2** Connect the speakers to the amplifier
- 3** Connect the CD player to the amplifier
- 4** Plug the power cord into a power outlet
- 5** Enjoying your music!

1 Install batteries in the remote control unit



2 Connect the speakers to the amplifier

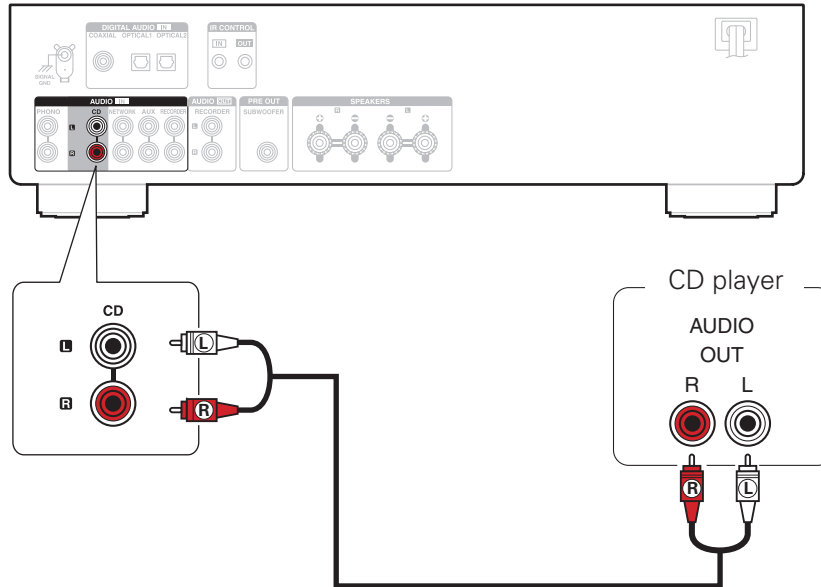


Connecting the speaker cables

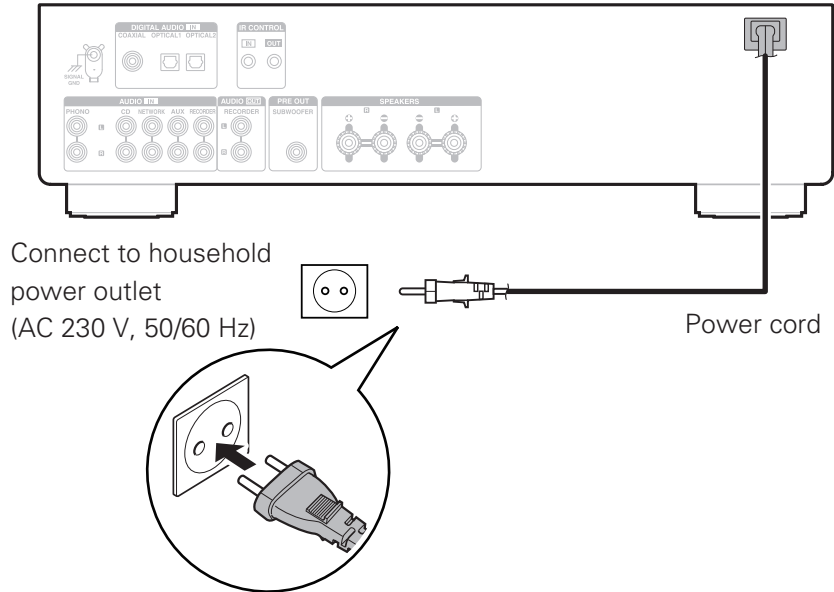
- 1 Peel off about 10 mm of sheathing from the tip of the speaker cable, then either twist the core wire tightly or apply solder to it.
- 2 Turn the speaker terminal counterclockwise to loosen it.
- 3 Insert the speaker cable's core wire to all the way into the speaker terminal.
- 4 Turn the speaker terminal clockwise to tighten it.



3 Connect the CD player to the amplifier

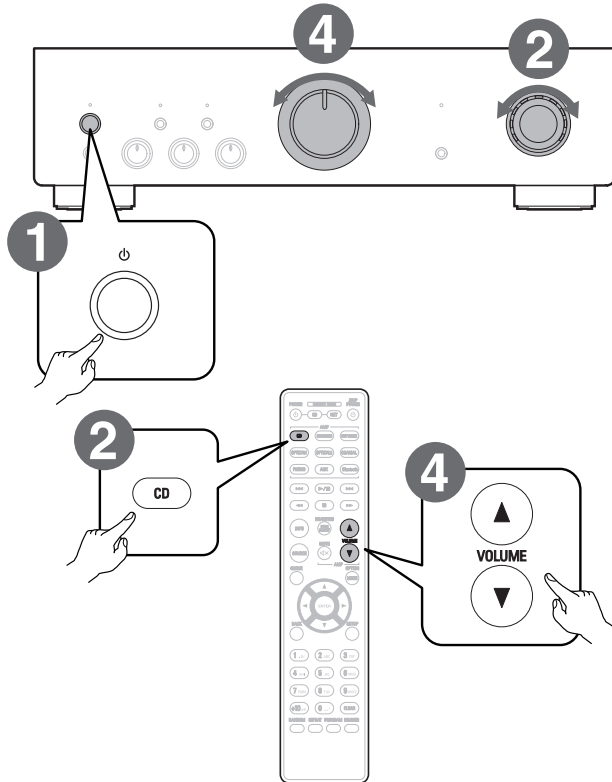


4 Plug the power cord into a power outlet



5 Enjoying your music!

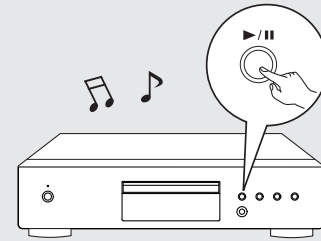
❑ Begin CD playback



1 Press the power operation button.
Turn VOLUME on the main unit to adjust the volume to the lowest level before turning on the power.

2 Set the input source to “CD”.
The “CD” input indicator lights.

3 Play the CD player.

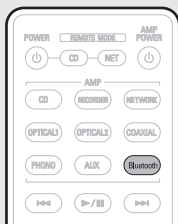


4 Adjust the volume.

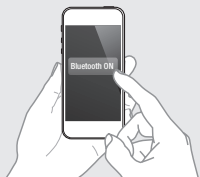
■ Enjoying music using Bluetooth

1 Press Bluetooth to select Bluetooth.

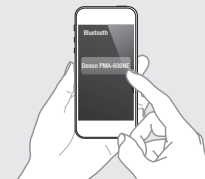
When using for the first time, the unit will go into the pairing mode automatically and the DIGITAL IN/BLUETOOTH indicator on the main unit will blink in blue in intervals of about 1 second.



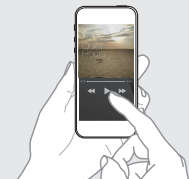
2 Activate Bluetooth on your mobile device.



3 Select “Denon PMA-600NE” from the Bluetooth device list on your mobile device.



4 Play music using any app on your device.



- To pair with other Bluetooth devices, press and hold Bluetooth on the remote control until the DIGITAL IN/BLUETOOTH indicator on the main unit will blink in blue in intervals of about 1 second.

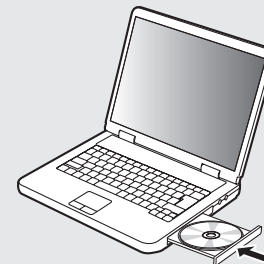
