


Adapter Control

Adapter LED Indicator	light flashing quickly(Flash once every 300ms)	The device searches for pairing status
	light flashing slowly (Flash every 1s)	The connection is successful

Bluetooth pairing: After the adapter is plugged into the conference device, it will automatically enter the pairing mode and the indicator will blink quickly. After the Bluetooth function of omnidirectional microphone is turned on, the indicator will blink slowly after the pairing is successful.

Keypad/Indicator Description

Long press for 5 seconds



Microphone Status Indicator	The green light is always on when working normally; the red light is always on when the microphone is mute.
Volume Status Indicator	The green light is on when microphone working normally, the brightness of status LED will increase or decrease with the speaker volume up or down.

Charging Indicator	When the battery is charging, the indicator light is green; when the battery is fully charged, the indicator light is off; when the battery is low, the status indicator light is red
Bluetooth Status Indicator	When the Bluetooth is pairing, the blue light flashes; when the pairing is successful, the blue light is always on







Operating Instructions

- 1. Bluetooth connection instructions: press the " \$ " button, the indicator blue light flashes, enter the Bluetooth pairing mode; turn on the Bluetooth function of the mobile phone, search for the corresponding Bluetooth name for pairing, the blue light is always on after the pairing is successful; press the " \$ " button again to turn off the Bluetooth function (When connecting with a Bluetooth adapter, please check the Bluetooth adapter instructions)
- 2. Instructions for turn on and off:press and hold the " \circ " button for 3 seconds to turn on the speakerphone master, and press the " \circ " button again for 3 seconds to turn off the speakerphone master; in addition, when the USB is connected to a computer device, the speakerphone master will automatically turn on. When the speakerphone master is not connected to any device, the speakerphone master will shut down after 3 minutes
